- "Wheels on Willy" is held under USAC/USCF permit (pending). All USAC/USCF & WCA rules apply.
- **Approved Helmets Required (On your head while riding anywhere near course), per USAC/USCF rules.....Duh!!!**
- You must have a valid USAC/USCF license to race. "Citizen" and Non-USAC/USCF registered riders must purchase a USAC/USCF 1 day license for \$ 10. Registration fees include USAC/USCF & WCA surcharges. Race day registration begins at 8:00 AM and ends 15 minutes before each race. USAC/USCF licenses & renewals will be available at registration.
- We reserve the right to cancel or combine fields (mainly if category turnout is too low). Minimum and Maximum Field Sizes as stated above, per USAC/USCF rules.
- Registration and Restroom facilities located close to Start/Finish line at, 1501 Williamson Street. Respect our Neighbors, Please!!

A Wisconsin Cycling Association Cup Series Event with WCA Category & Team Points Awarded

* WCA Series Points awarded in the Masters 4/5 and Masters 1/2/3 races will be awarded by top placings in each of the following "Masters" Age Groups: 30+, 40+ & 50+.

** LAJORS Medals will be awarded in all Junior Age Groups and Under 23 Riders in the Women Open and Pro/1/2/3 Races

Maximum Field Sizes: Maximum field size limits set by USAC/USCF and/or course safety requirements.

Course: ~1.0 kilometer per lap.....revised rectangular course with the same long straight gradual uphill stretch to the finish line on Williamson Street. *This classic urban criterium course has simply shifted 1 block south and will go counter-clockwise.*

Directions: Madison, Wisconsin is about 3 hours from Chicago, 75 minutes from Milwaukee & about 4.5 hours from Minneapolis. From I-90/94, take East Washington/US 151 South towards Capitol; go about 5 miles & then Left/South onto Dickinson or Baldwin & follow "Bike Race" signs. Plug, "1500 Williamson Street" into Mapquest, Yahoo-Maps, etc.
