Directions: From Milwaukee/Madison - Take I 90/94 west to STH 33 west (exit 106) - West on STH 33 through Baraboo to West Baraboo - Continue west on STH 136 at stop lights (intersection of STH 33 and US 12) - In Rock Springs continue straight on STH 154 - STH 154 west to CTH CH Race headquarters is at the Sauk County Health Care Center, S4555 CTH CH

“Circuit of Sauk” is held under USAC permit (pending). All USAC & WCA rules apply. You must have a valid license to race. One day and annual licenses will be available for purchase. Registration fees include USAC & WCA surcharges. Registration opens at 7:30 AM and closes 15 minutes before each event
