Course Description: Scenic loop on rural roads with challenging climbs. The half lap course starts in front of LaRue Tavern on CR PF to McCoy Rd to CR W to Freedom Rd to Weinke Rd to Denzer Rd to CR PF and back to the finish near the intersection of PF and Diamond Hill Rd. The full lap course follows the half lap, however it continues up Freedom Rd past Weinke Rd to Balfanz Rd to CR C to Denzer Rd to CR PF and back to the finish near the intersection of PF and Diamond Hill Rd
